# **Applying for Employment Insurance (EI)**

**ROE Issue Date:** CBE will automatically have Records of Employment (ROE) issued electronically to Service Canada via the Web for 10-month support staff by July 6, 2019.

Applying For Employment Insurance: Apply as soon as possible after you stop working. Do not wait until you get your ROE to apply. If you wait more than four weeks after your last day of work to apply, you may lose benefits.

How To File Your Claim: To file, please go to <u>www.servicecanada.gc.ca</u> or <u>www.canada.ca</u> – Scroll down page and select "My Service Canada Account"
