FIELD OF STUDY

Unrestricted

VALUE & NUMBER OF AWARDS

Seven awards; four will be determined by the financial need of the applicant (4 x \$1,500 awards); three will have no financial need restrictions (3 x \$1,000)

ELIGIBILITY

Open to students registered in grade 12 who are completing the requirements of a high school diploma. Applicants must have marks sufficient for entrance to a post-secondary area of study.

Student must have a parent or guardian who is a current member in the Calgary Board of Education Staff Association (PSS and Main Body).

Applicants are required to submit an original essay describing how this award will impact you in attaining your educational goals. The essay must be no more than 500 words in length (one page, typed or printed).

Applicants are encouraged to submit letters of reference. Letters may be provided from a school official, employer, or a community leader representing a community-based organization.

Selection will be based on the level of financial need, where applicable, and the essay.

SELECTION

Recipients are selected in September by the EducationMatters Student Awards Selection Committee. To claim the award, within eighteen (18) months of notification of award, the recipient must be registered in an eligible program of post-secondary study in Canada. Payments are made to the post-secondary institution.
