Article 10 - Attending SA's Convention

Article 10 - Staff Association Convention

10.1 Continuous and term-specific employees will be allowed at least two (2) days, with pay, to attend the annual Staff Association Convention unless operational/work requirements prevent the absence from work of an employee for both days, in which case the employee will be allowed at least one (1) day, with pay, to attend. Employees not required to work either of the days of the Staff Association Convention shall not be entitled to receive additional compensation for time spent at the Staff Association Convention.

Please note:

- Continuous employees Since Convention days are paid days, the expectation is that you are
 either at work or attending Convention unless alternative arrangements have been mutually
 agreed to with your immediate supervisor.
 - You are not paid extra if the time you spend at Convention exceeds your regular paid hours.
- *Time sheeted employees* You are welcome to attend Convention and participate in sessions, but are not paid for doing so.

Westside Recreation Centre

- Please arrive no earlier than 9:30am as sessions begin at 10:30am and the centre requires time for their early morning facility users to exit the building.
- A registration table will be located inside the lobby for members to receive a wristband and SA's appreciation gift. Westside staff will be available to assist you through the facility.
